Subhas Chandra Bose, also known as Netaji, emerged as a prominent leader in India’s fight for independence from British rule. During World War II, Bose identified an opportunity to advance India’s cause by aligning with Axis powers such as Germany and Japan, who were adversaries of the British Empire. In 1942, Bose established the

Indian National Army (INA) in Singapore, recruiting Indian prisoners of war and civilians living in Southeast Asia. Despite facing challenges, including resource shortages and equipment deficits, Bose's leadership inspired thousands to join the INA's ranks. Their most significant military engagement occurred during the Burma Campaign in 1944, where they fought alongside Japanese forces against the British Indian Army. Although the campaign ended in defeat for the INA and its allies, Bose's determination and the sacrifices of INA soldiers left an indelible mark on India's struggle for independence. Bose's establishment of the INA and his unwavering commitment to liberating India from British colonial rule exemplify his bold and decisive leadership.
